ARE THE MOLDED PLASTIC SCRUBBERS YOU ARE USING SAFE? OR, COULD THEY EXPOSE YOU TO FIRE AND SAFETY RISKS?

Portable air scrubbers with molded plastic cabinets can offer a number of user benefits over products with fabricated metal cabinets. They are typically lighter. If designed properly, the cabinets are virtually indestructible in normal use, much more likely to maintain their appearance and shape over time, and less likely to damage objects they may bump against. In addition to the huge variation in quality from one molded product to another, users should pay special attention to the things they can do to make sure they know the product they are buying is safe.

FIRE SAFETY

Why is fire safety important? Many of the plastic resins commonly used for rotational molding are highly flammable, and not intended or rated for use as enclosures that house energized electrical components. Cabinets made with these resins can potentially erupt into a fireball if exposed to a flame or heat, and burn aggressively. There's only one way to ensure that a product is fire-safe: make sure that the manufacturer has submitted it to a Nationally Recognized Tested Laboratory (NRTL), such as UL, Intertek Testing Services (ETL), or CSA for thorough testing, and that the NRTL has certified it to pass the UL flammability & flame-spread standards.

ELECTRICAL SAFETY

Why is electrical safety important? OSHA and CSA safety standards for construction and general industry require the use of electrical products that meet applicable UL standards per the NEC (National Electrical Code). Products made with UL Recognized components do not meet this requirement. The only way to know that the overall product does is if the manufacturer has submitted it to one of the NRTL for electrical safety testing, and the NRTL has certified it.
